Three new documents were also approved by Council: AG-9, *Guidelines for Contractor Audits*, MFI-18, *Affiliates and Related Entities*, MFI 21 – AD-1, *Overhead Joint Operations Addendum*. We are also happy to report that COPAS-Colorado was well represented at the National level. We had 14 members in attendance.
