Jake Vossen, Director of Audit Quality and Partner with Hein & Associates LLP, presented an update on the new oil and gas reserve disclosures rules effective for 2009 financial statements titled "Oil and Gas Reserve Disclosure – What you need to know for 2010." An especially interesting part of his presentation was his summary of the comment letter feedback from the SEC to E&P companies on their 2009 10-K disclosures. Turn out was approximately 30 members from 16 different companies.

The next Financial Reporting meeting will be held on January 11, 2011 at noon at Encana, 370 17th Street, 40th floor conference room.
